

MEMORANDUM OF JOINT STATEMENT OF INTENT

- I. Parties – This Statement of Intent is between Regent University located in the United States of America and National Yunlin University of Science & Technology located in Taiwan, Republic of China.
- II. Purpose – In the pursuit of excellence in legal education, the faculties of law of the Universities wish to enter into further discussions on potential cooperative activities to enhance student achievement, institutional research, continued higher legal education, and promotion of the rule of law.
- III. Goals – During the term of this Statement of Intent, the faculties of law of the Universities hope to discuss cooperative efforts that might include exchanges of faculty, visiting student programs, participation by National Yunlin University of Science & Technology graduates and faculty in any Regent University LL.M. in American Legal Studies, and other programs and efforts serving the Purpose of this Statement of Intent.
- IV. Responsibilities of the Universities – This Statement of Intent expresses the intent of the Universities but neither University shall be under any legal obligation to the other until both Universities execute a formal agreement that describes their respective rights and obligations.
- V. Term – This Statement of Intent shall be effective for five years from the date both Universities have signed and may be amended from time to time by mutual agreement. Either University may terminate this Statement of Intent on thirty days written notice to the other.

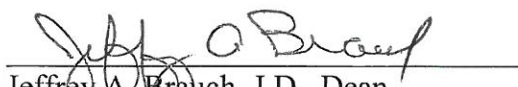
