

ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
COLLEGE OF HUMANITIES AND APPLIED SCIENCE,
NATIONAL YUNLIN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, TAIWAN
AND
GRADUATE SCHOOL OF LETTERS
HOKKAIDO UNIVERSITY, JAPAN

College of Humanities and Applied Science, National Yunlin University of Science and Technology, and the Graduate School of Letters, Hokkaido University hereby conclude this agreement to promote educational and academic exchange and cooperation between the two institutions.

1. Each institution will make an effort to promote and develop cooperation in the following activities, upon the principles of equality and reciprocity.
 - (1) Exchange of faculty members and research fellows.
 - (2) Exchange of students.
 - (3) Exchange of academic materials, publications and information.
 - (4) Conducting joint research projects and organizing symposiums.
2. In order to carry out the above-mentioned activities, a memorandum will be exchanged after mutual consultation between the two institutions. However, neither institution will assume any financial responsibilities due to this agreement.
3. The agreement shall come into effect the date on which the agreement is signed by both parties and shall be valid for a period of 5 (five) years. It will thereafter be automatically renewed every 5 (five) years unless one institution notifies the other of its intention to terminate the agreement at least 3 (three) months prior to the expiration date.
4. The agreement is executed in English in 2 (two) originals and each institution will retain 1 (one) original.

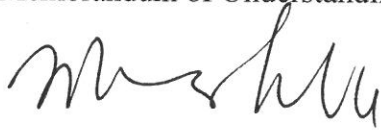

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON STUDENT EXCHANGE
BETWEEN
COLLEGE OF HUMANITIES AND APPLIED SCIENCE,
NATIONAL YUNLIN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, TAIWAN
AND
GRADUATE SCHOOL OF LETTERS
HOKKAIDO UNIVERSITY, JAPAN**

Under the Academic Exchange Agreement concluded on 25th Jan. 2017, between College of Humanities and Applied Science, National Yunlin University of Science and Technology and the Graduate School of Letters, Hokkaido University, both institutions shall implement the exchange of students as follows.

1. The students participating in the exchange program during the term of this memorandum will be selected initially by the home institution, and the host institution will make the final admission decision in each case. Applications each year must meet the deadlines designated by each institution.
2. Each institution will enroll 3 (three) students from the other each year; however, this number can be increased for a specified year with prior and mutual approval of both institutions.
3. The period of enrollment of the students at the host institution will not in principle exceed 1 (one) year.
4. The host institution will waive fees for entrance examinations, admission, and tuition for the students from the other institution.
5. Travel expenses, cost of living or other necessary expenses incurred by the students will be the responsibility of the individual students and/or their sponsors. This does not preclude the application for scholarships from independent institutions to cover such expenses.
6. The field of study for each student will be such that the host institution can appoint a qualified advisor and provide appropriate courses of study.
7. In order to successfully carry out study abroad, each student will possess the level of language ability requested by the host institution to complete the appropriate course of study.
8. Participating students will continue as candidates for degrees at their home institution and will not be candidates for degrees at the host institution.

9. Each institution agrees to provide to the other documentation of course work completed by the students and appropriate academic information on their performance. Units passed at the host institution can be accepted for credit at the home institution.
10. The host institution will assist the students in finding adequate housing on or near the campus.
11. To be eligible to participate in the exchange program, students must purchase the health insurance required by the host institution. The costs of any health insurance required, as well as any medical expenses not covered by such insurance, will be the personal responsibility of the exchange students.
12. During the period of the students' stay at the host institution, both institutions will work cooperatively to ensure the safety of students.
13. In the event of termination of this Memorandum, both institutions shall provide all support services stated in the above Memorandum of Understanding for the exchange students until the end of their exchange.
14. Both institutions agree that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, physical disability, age, or creed be excluded from participation under the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding.
