



MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING
between
NAGOYA UNIVERSITY OF COMMERCE AND BUSINESS (JAPAN)
and
National Yunlin University of Science and Technology (Yunlin, Taiwan)

NAGOYA UNIVERSITY OF COMMERCE AND BUSINESS and National Yunlin University of Science and Technology, hereinafter referred to individually as "Institution" and jointly as "Institutions," desiring to establish collaborative relations in a mutually beneficial association have agreed that:

1. The two institutions shall encourage co-operation in Business and Management Studies.
2. The two institutions shall seek to promote activities such as:
 - exchange between the two institutions of:
 - Academic staff for purposes of fostering research collaborations, including graduate theses supervision;
 - Academic staff for purposes of interchange of teaching expertise;
 - Academic staff for the purpose of short-term visiting lectureships;
 - Administrative staff for purpose of transferring knowledge of administrative practices;
 - Undergraduate and postgraduate students in study abroad and/or student-exchange programs, to benefit from access to expertise or resources available at both institutions.
 - Provision of briefing services by each institution for visitors from the other institution.
 - Exchange of information and materials that are of mutual interest.
 - Any other form of co-operation which the two institutions may jointly arrange.
3. The two institutions shall decide through consultation the specific areas and details of co-operation within the framework of this Memorandum of Understanding and shall consult from time to time at the request of either institution for the purpose of reviewing the operation of this agreement.
4. The details of co-operation and the associated financial arrangements for each specific area of activity shall be settled through consultation between the two institutions and shall be spelled out in separate Appendices which may from time to time be attached to this Memorandum of Understanding. The Memorandum of Understanding shall become operative on signing and shall

remain in force for an initial period of five (5) years.

5. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended and supplemented by agreement between the two institutions.
6. The institutions shall confer concerning the renewal of this Memorandum of Understanding six (6) months prior to the date of expiration.
7. Either institution may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding by giving twelve (12) months' notice in writing to the other institution. Any projects, training, or exchanges that may have commenced at either institution before the date of termination may be completed by special agreement between the two institutions. For conditions not covered by this agreement, or for problems that arise during the course of the agreement, both parties agree to refrain from unilateral action and to consult and negotiate mutually acceptable decisions.
8. In signing this Memorandum of Understanding, the two institutions jointly affirm that intellectual integrity; freedom of inquiry and exchange of ideas; and equal dignity of all persons must govern the actions of all members of both institutions. Furthermore, the two institutions are committed to incorporating sustainability principles into their collaborative efforts, ensuring that environmental, social, and economic sustainability considerations are an integral part of their joint initiatives.

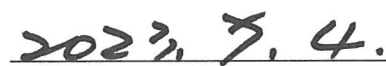
