



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

National Yunlin University of Science and Technology (Yunlin, Taiwan)

and

The University of Electro-Communications (Tokyo, Japan)

National Yunlin University of Science and Technology, located at 123, University Road, Section 3, Douliou, Yunlin 64002, Taiwan, and the University of Electro-Communications, located at 1-5-1 Chofugaoka Chofushi Tokyo, Japan 182-8585, wishing to develop academic and cultural interchange between the two institutions in education, research and other areas, agree to formally establish a collaborative relationship with each other. Subject to mutual consent, the provisions of the agreement are as follows:

Article I.

The areas of collaboration include any program offered by either university in which the two institutions believe collaboration is feasible and desirable and which would develop and enhance a mutually beneficial relationship between the two universities.

Article II.

Subject to the approval of the President of each institution and the availability of funding, assistance shall be carried out through any one or more of the following activities or programs as mutually agreed to by both parties:

- i. Student Exchange Program
- ii. Faculty Exchange Program
- iii. Special Short-term Academic Programs
- iv. Staff Development Projects
- v. Joint Research and Activities

Article III.

This MOU imposes no financial obligation on either institution. Both institutions understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

Article IV.

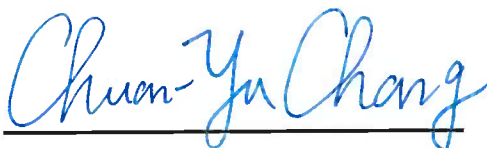
Both institutions shall not conduct research for the purpose of military use in all activities carried out under this MOU and shall comply with all applicable export control laws and regulations for all activities carried out under this MOU. Neither institution shall use goods, technologies and duplications thereof, which have been obtained under this MOU, for the purposes of disturbing international peace and security, including any military activities. Nor institution shall permit any third party to use the aforementioned goods, technologies and duplications for the aforementioned purposes. This provision shall survive the termination of this MOU by nature without limitation of effective term.

Article V.

This cooperation agreement shall become effective as soon as the presidents of both institutions sign it, and will remain in force for a period of five years. This MOU may be renewed by mutual agreement prior to the date of expiry. Either party reserves the right to terminate this agreement upon a one-year prior written declaration by the terminating party.

Article VI.

Any amendment to this MOU shall be based on the mutual consent and requires the written approval of the President of each institution that shall be appended hereto. This declaration will become effective with the agreement of both parties.

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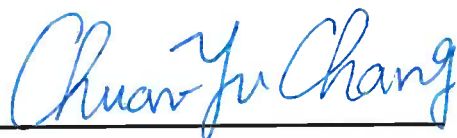
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
