This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU), executed by and between:

The "**UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES LOS BAÑOS**", a constituent university of the **UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES**, the National University, created by virtue of Act No. 1870, as amended and reorganized and operating by virtue of P.D. 58 and R.A. 9500, with office address at College, Los Baños, Laguna, represented herein by its Chancellor, **DR. JOSE V. CAMACHO, JR.**, hereinafter referred to as "**UPLB**"

-and-

**NATIONAL YUNLIN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY**, established in 1991, is a public university located at 123, University Road, Section 3, Douliou, Yunlin 64002, Taiwan, represented herein by its President, **Dr. NENG-SHU YANG**, and hereinafter referred to as "**NYUST**";

The **UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES LOS BAÑOS**, and **NATIONAL YUNLIN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY** recognizing the benefits to their respective universities from the establishment of institutional links, conclude this MOU.

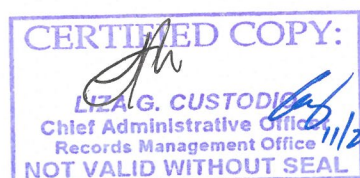
1. The purpose of this MOU is to develop academic and educational cooperation and promote mutual understanding between the two universities;
2. Both universities agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity;

- a. Exchange of faculty and researchers
  - b. Exchange of students
  - c. Conduct of collaborative research projects;
  - d. Conduct of lectures and symposia;
  - e. Exchange of academic information and materials; and
  - f. Promote other academic cooperation as mutually agreed
3. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MOU will be separately negotiated and agreed upon between the faculties, schools or institutes which carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective countries after full consultation and approval.
  4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of cooperation stated in clause 2 maybe restricted depending upon the availability of resources and financial support at the universities concerned.
  5. All collaborative activities and exchanges under this general MOU shall not be conducted or enforced unless a Specific Activity Agreement is executed between the parties herein observing the same formalities and all limitations specified herein.
  6. Should any collaborative research activity under this MOU result in any potential for intellectual property, both universities shall seek an equitable and fair understanding as to the ownership and other property interests that may arise. The understanding shall be based on the laws, rules and guidelines then implemented at each university.
  7. Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor will any constraints be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out the MOU.
  8. This MOU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both universities.
  9. Within thirty (30) days from the effectivity of this MOU, each party shall inform the other party in writing the name of its staff/office who/which will serve as its liaison officer/office with the other party under this MOU.
  10. This MOU is valid for a period of five (5) years from the date of signing by the representatives of both universities. This MOU may be renewed subject to the review and renegotiation by both parties. Such review and negotiation shall be conducted within sixty (60) days prior to expiration of the MOU. This MOU shall



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take effect from the date of the latest signature below.

11. Should any disagreement arise out of the application, interpretation, or implementation of this MOU, the universities shall endeavour to exercise best efforts to negotiate their differences. Alternative methods of dispute resolution shall be exhausted before resorting to court litigation.
12. This MOU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the universities, upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than six (6) months before the termination date.
13. In the event of any unforeseen incident during collaborative activities in either country, both universities agree to negotiate a mutually acceptable solution. As far as practicable, these solutions shall be incorporated to the specific agreements stated in paragraph 3.
14. This MOU shall be executed in English.
15. This MOU may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

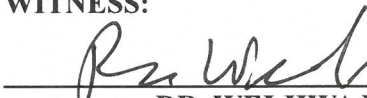

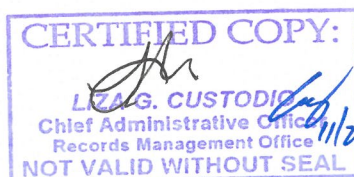
