

THIS AGREEMENT OF ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AND COOPERATION is made on the 10th day of
May, 2002 BETWEEN

NATIONAL YUNLIN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, YUNLIN, TAIWAN

AND

SWINBURNE UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, MELBOURNE, AUSTRALIA

1. OBJECTIVES AND FORMS OF COOPERATION

- 1.1 Under the terms of this agreement Swinburne University of Technology and National Yunlin University of Science and Technology agree to promote the development of university education and scholarly research in areas of common interest.
- 1.2 Both institutions agree to the following general forms of cooperation:
- identification of major areas, disciplines or topics of mutual interest which could lead to exchange or joint activity;
 - exploration of opportunities for staff development including visits by members of academic, research, administration and management staff;
 - exploration of joint research interests between the two institutions; and
 - exploration of opportunities to support the exchange of students.

2. TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT

- 2.1 This agreement shall commence on the execution date and shall continue for Three (3) years.
- 2.2 Details of specific areas of co-operation shall be drafted in the form of an agreement and attached as separate Schedules. The terms and duration of each Schedule are to be independently agreed, and will be signed and dated by the partners. Any revision or modification will be in writing and by mutual agreement.
- 2.3 Either institution may, by written notice of six (6) months, give notice to the other of its intention to terminate this agreement.
- 2.4 If the agreement is terminated as set out in Clause 2.3, it is agreed that both parties will work together to ensure that cooperative activities that have already commenced are, wherever possible, completed under the terms of the agreement.
- 2.5 In the absence of an early termination, the renewal of this Agreement shall be discussed by the two parties not less than six (6) months prior to the expiry date of the agreement.

The parties have mutually agreed to work together and in recognition of this they have executed this agreement.
