

GENERAL INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENT
between
NATIONAL YUNLIN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, TAIWAN
and
UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA, AUSTRALIA

The National Yunlin University of Science and Technology and the University of South Australia do hereby enter into an agreement to promote international cooperation in education and research. This is based on the principles of equality and reciprocal benefit.

Both Universities agree to pursue cooperation under the terms and conditions identified in this General International Agreement.

- The Agreement covers the following activities. These do not exclude the possibility of additional activities which might be separately agreed:
 - Collaborative educational programs.
 - Collaborative research projects.
 - Collaborative staff development programs.
 - Exchange of staff and students.
 - Exchange of publications, reports and other academic information.
- The Agreement specifies general areas of potential cooperation. It is understood that the enactment of the Agreement shall require a specific schedule identifying the conditions governing a nominated activity.
- The Agreement shall be effective from the date of signature by the representative of each University who is competent to sign on behalf of that Institution.

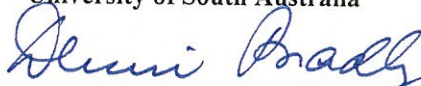
