

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

- **NATIONAL YUNLIN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY**—having its registered office at 123, Section 3, University Road, Douliou, Yunlin, Taiwan, R.O.C. (hereafter called “NYUST”).

and

- **LONDON METROPOLITAN UNIVERSITY** a company limited by guarantee no. 974438 incorporated under the laws of England it having its registered office at 31, Jewry Street, London EC3N 2EY (hereafter called “the University”).
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1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be of no effect until it is signed by or on behalf of both parties.
- 1.2. The duration of the Memorandum is five years from the date of signing.

2. NATURE OF CO-OPERATION

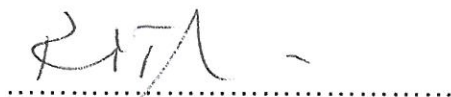
- 2.1. This Memorandum of Understanding describes an intention to collaborate on educational projects between NYUST and the University . Both institutions will encourage direct contact and cooperation between their academic staff, departments, institutes and other research centres subject to the provisions of this Memorandum.
- 2.2. Within academic and professional service areas to be mutually designated, NYUST and the University agree to develop collaborative undergraduate, post graduate, research and third stream opportunities as appropriate.
- 2.3. Both NYUST and University agree to commit resources, both human and financial, to develop the above activities and to seek external funding for the same.
- 2.4. Other areas for collaboration may be identified in the future and cooperative projects related to them may be developed between both NYUST and the University in the spirit of institutional friendship and cultural, educational and scientific cooperation.
- 2.5. Both parties will name a liaison person to be the prime focus for advancing the development of activities related to this memorandum.

3. FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

- 3.1. Emendations to the Memorandum of Understanding may be incorporated with the mutual written consent of both parties.
- 3.2. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be subject to review and renegotiation at five-year intervals. Should such a review not take place; the arrangements contained in the Memorandum shall lapse without further notice.
- 3.3. This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by the authorised representative of either university at any time by written notice. Such notice must be given at least six months before it becomes effective. Termination shall not affect the rights of anybody exchanged under this agreement prior to receipt of such notice.
- 3.4. Where joint activities lead to collaborative provision leading to an award of either or both parties, or to an activity that involves the transfer of money from one party to the other, both parties will negotiate and agree a discrete agreement to be set out in the terms of a Memorandum of Agreement, which will include a financial agreement. Cooperation of this kind will only be deemed to be legally viable if a Memorandum of Agreement is signed by both parties.

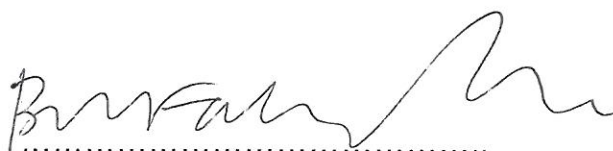

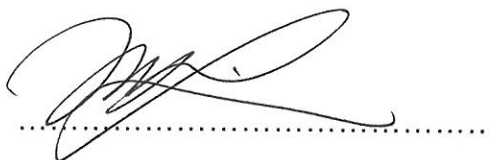
