MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is signed between the National Yunlin University of Science and Technology, represented by, the President, Tsong Ming LIN, and Moscow Aviation Institute (State Technical University) (MAI), represented by its Rector Academician Alexander Matveenkov. The MEMORANDUM is based on the discussions which took place on June 22nd in Moscow, Russia.

ARTICLE 1 GENERAL

Both Parties expressed their views on bilateral cooperation and have discussed possible opportunities to organize this cooperation. Both Parties have come to an understanding that they will aspire to develop cooperation proceeding from the following programs of MAI for foreign citizens:

1. **For school leavers.** A full-time program in more than 40 majors covering the *design* of all types of flying vehicles, their engines and all onboard mechanical, electrical and electronic devices and subsystems (**5 years, 6 months** of duration; a ME certificate or Diploma of Engineering).
 2. **For bachelors.** A Master degree program according to one of the chosen specialty (**2 or 3 years** of duration; a ME certificate).
 3. **For masters.** A Ph.D. or Sc.D. program in more than 50 research areas supporting the development of the advanced aerospace engineering and related branches of science and technology (**3 years** of duration; a Ph.D. or Sc.D. certificate).
 4. **For students and specialists in aerospace engineering.** A short-term program according to one of the chosen specialty (**1 to 10 months** of duration; a special certificate in both Russian and English).
- The above named *academic programs 1, 2, 3* are available in *Russian Language*.
The above named *academic program 4* is available both in Russian and in English.
5. **For foreign students and specialists.** Special Russian Language course at MAI Pre-School (**1 academic year** of duration). MAI offers our courses of the Russian language in Moscow, Russia or any place abroad.
 6. **Joint educational process** by realization of real project.
 7. **Research works** on commercial terms.

ARTICLE 2 ARRANGEMENTS AND FUNDING

To implement the collaborative activities envisaged under the MEMORANDUM, representatives of the Parties may meet periodically to negotiate and conclude project agreements and programs of cooperation, including their financing.

The financial arrangement, rights to intellectual property and publication of articles relating to each project agreement and programs of cooperation will be in accordance to the specific agreement and programs of cooperation covering each project. The Parties acknowledge that in the absence of any specific agreement to the contrary, all expenses of salary, travel, living and allied costs will be determined at the discretion, and be the responsibility of the visitor's home university.

ARTICLE 3 MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

The Parties can appoint representatives to manage and oversee the joint management activities. The representatives of the Contracting Parties can meet as and when necessary to review progress in the implementation of the agreed arrangements, define new areas and programs of cooperation as well as discuss matters related to the MEMORANDUM.

ARTICLE 4 AMENDMENTS

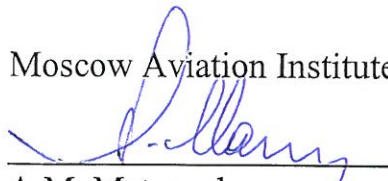
This MEMORANDUM may be amended by mutual consent of the Parties.

ARTICLE 5 TERM OF AGREEMENT

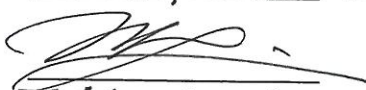
This MEMORANDUM shall commence on the date of its execution by the Parties and shall remain in force for a period of five years. Thereafter, it shall renew itself automatically for successive periods of five years unless either of the Parties notifies the other party in writing of its desire to terminate it at least six months before the expiry of its initial or the relevant extended period.

The termination of this MEMORANDUM shall not affect the implementation of the projects or programs established under it prior to such termination.
