



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Between

National Yunlin University of Science and Technology, Yunlin, Taiwan

And

Indian Education Society Mumbai, India

This Understanding, made and executed between

National Yunlin University of Science and Technology (YUNTECH), located at
University Road, Section 3, Douliou, Yunlin 64002, Taiwan,

AND

Indian Education Society (IES), registered as a Society under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and as a public charitable trust, under the Maharashtra Public Trusts Act, 1950, having its registered office at Raja Shivaji Vidya Sankul, Hindu Colony, Dadar, Mumbai, 400014, India.

Preamble

- I. YUNTECH and IES are desirous of developing academic and cultural interchange between the two institutions in education, research and other areas, and, to achieve this aim, are desirous of entering into this Understanding, to formalise their areas of co-operation and interchanges.
- II. YUNTECH is a flagship university with four colleges, the College of Engineering, College of Management, College of Design, and College of Humanities and Applied Sciences. These four colleges account for 20 undergraduate, 26 master's and 12 doctoral programs.
- III. IES has established and administers and manages schools and the IES Management College and Research Centre (MCRC) and the IES College of Architecture (COA).

- IV. YUNTECH and IES have arrived at and consented to the terms and conditions for operation and execution of this MOU and the same is set out in the succeeding paragraphs.
- V. This MOU is subject to the same being in conformity with and compliance of the statutes and regulations of Taiwan and India, regulating this MOU.

THIS MOU WITNESSES AND THE PARTIES AGREE, ACCEPT AND UNDERTAKE AS UNDER :

1. This MOU is always subject to finance made available and released by YUNTECH for the purposes of fulfilling the terms of this MOU and compliance of statutory and regulatory requirements and fulfillment of the terms and conditions of this MOU.
2. YUNTECH and IES are desirous of collaborating on :
 - i. Student Exchange Program
 - ii. Faculty Exchange Program
 - iii. Special Short-term Academic Programs
 - iv. Staff Development Projects
 - v. Joint Research and Activities
3. This MOU becomes effective and operational from the date of signing of this MOU and shall be in force for 5 (five) years from the date of its execution, subject to termination clauses set out in this MOU.
4. This MOU can be terminated:
 - 4.1 By either party, without cause, by giving advance written notice of one month to the non-terminating party;
 - 4.2 By either party, at the end of the notice period, if the non-terminating party has not rectified any breach of which a 30 day breach rectification notice had been given by the terminating party. Rectification of the breach has to be confirmed by written communication between the parties and written acceptance of rectification of such breach, by the party alleging the breach;
 - 4.3 By either party, at the end of the Notice given by the terminating party, to the non-terminating party for irremediable breaches;
5. Any amendment to this MOU shall be based on the mutual consent and requires the written approval of Managements/ Boards of YUNTECH and IES respectively

that shall be appended hereto. This declaration will become effective with the agreement of both parties.

6. This MOU is regulated by Indian laws and all disputes shall be adjudicated by Mumbai Courts having jurisdiction, including pecuniary jurisdiction, over the subject matter.
7. There will be no legal or financial obligations on either institution. This MOU is only an understanding to work together for mutual benefit in the field of academics
8. In order to oversee this MOU and coordinate with the associated Colleges and Departments, units and subsidiaries for separate supplementary agreements, both the Parties agree that the institutional points of contact shall be the following:

A. **For IES-** Dr. Mohan B Rao- Associate Dean- External Collaborations- IESMCRC.

B. **For YUNTECH-** Dr. Shi-Chang Tseng – Dean of Office of International Affairs
