



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

(hereinafter referred to as "MOU")

BETWEEN

National Yunlin University of Science and Technology (YunTech)

A flagship technological university founded in 1991 based on the Ministry of Education Taiwan (80) School Letter No. 32964 and Ministry of Education Taiwan (86) Technology (2) Letter No. 86082831, which has its registered address at 123 University Rd., Sec. 3, Douliu City, Yunlin 64002, Taiwan (hereinafter referred to as "YunTech")

AND

KING MONGKUT'S UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY NORTH BANGKOK (KMUTNB)

An autonomous state university established under the laws of Thailand which has its registered address at 1518 Pracharat 1 Rd., Wongsawang, Bangsue, Bangkok 10800, Thailand (hereinafter referred to as "TGGS")

This non-exclusive MOU mentioned above records the intention of **YunTech** and **TGGS** to strengthen ties between the two institutions which might lead in future to the establishment of one or more partnership or collaboration agreements **for joint academic and professional training programmes, and joint research and human capital development.**

At present this MOU is made as a gesture of goodwill between the institutions, which may see the development of **links in the areas of:**

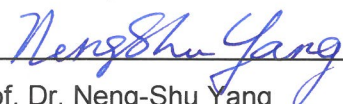
- a) Promotion of joint academic and professional training programmes.
- b) Promotion of joint research and development activities.
- c) Promotion of education and research for human capital development.
- d) Exchange of documentation and research material or facilities for the purpose of carrying out the joint or collaborative research projects.

Details of the implementation of any particular collaborative agreement leading to an award or implementation of the activities above shall be negotiated between the two institutions as such specific cases arise. Such an agreement will be legitimised by the completion of a specific Memorandum of Agreement or a formal agreement that has been agreed and signed by the institutions.

This is the first generation of this MOU. This MOU is subject to revision, renewal, or cancellation by mutual consent and becomes effective for a period of **three (3) years** upon completion of signature

by both the institutions with the right to terminate the MOU at any time without cause by giving three (3) months written notice to the other institution.
