



YunTech-MITS MANDARIN TEACHING CENTRE

AGREEMENT

between

National Yunlin University of Science and Technology (Yunlin, Taiwan)

and

Madanapalle Institute of Technology and Science (Madanapalle, India)

National Yunlin University of Science and Technology (YunTech), located at 123, University Road, Section 3, Douliou, Yunlin 64002, Taiwan, and Madanapalle Institute of Technology and Science (MITS), located at Post Box No: 14, Kadiri Road, Angallu (Village), Madanapalle-517325 Chittoor District, Andhra Pradesh, India, wishing to develop academic collaboration and encourage cross-cultural understanding, mutually agree to promote YunTech-MITS Mandarin Teaching Centre in accordance with the principles and guidelines set forth below.

YunTech and MITS will carry out activities to:

1. Set up Mandarin language training and cooperation programs centre;
2. YunTech has to arrange a qualified Mandarin teacher to MITS for three years, and pay the teacher's salary and ticket fare and relevant teaching materials;
3. MITS should offer residence with basic amenities, Indian Health insurance, VISA application support, and provide supplemental pay (about 300-400 US Dollars);
4. The Mandarin teacher should have teaching hours limited to 12 hours but maximum 18 hours per week;
5. The Mandarin teacher for the purpose of common training cooperation programs at multiple levels of Mandarin instruction;
6. MITS should appoint coordinator to help the Mandarin teacher to live in Madanapalle.

Effective Period of the Agreement

This Agreement shall become effective as soon as the presidents of both institutions sign it, and will remain in force for a period of three years. This Agreement will be automatically

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renewed on the same terms and conditions for another three years unless either party raises written notification 6 months prior to the expiry date. Two copies of the present agreement have been signed in English, both of them having the same legal validity and each keeps one.

Article 7: Amendments to the Agreement

Any amendment to this agreement shall be based on mutual consent and requires the written approval of the President of each institution that shall be appended hereto. This declaration will become effective with the agreement of both parties.



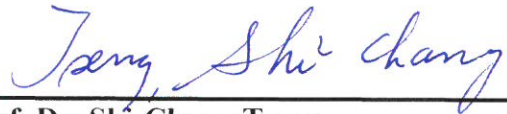
