



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Vocational and Technical Education Institutions in Taiwan, ROC

And

Vietnam National University

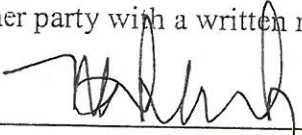
Representatives of National Yunlin University of Science and Technology, National Taichung Institute of Technology, Wenzao Ursuline College of Languages, Transworld Institute of Technology, in Taiwan, ROC and Vietnam National University, have held a series of discussions pertaining to the desirability and feasibility of a more formal relationship designed to strengthen the bonds between the two academic institutions and, in the process, contribute to greater understanding and communications between two cultures.

In recognition of the fact that meaningful programs envisioned in this Memorandum of Understanding require constant planning and attention, each institute will appoint representatives to serve as a Planning Committee which will concern itself with the following functions:

1. To maintain the effective communication on the approaches by which such a relationship can be most fruitful for all concerned in a certain period of each year.
2. To explore meaningful joint projects, including cultural exchanges, student and faculty visits and exchanges, cooperative researches, collaborative workshops, distance learning collaboration and the means to support them.
3. To create collaborative patterns for educational globalization, including the bilateral and multilateral recruitment policies and practices, cooperative mechanism for exchanging students and professors, international accreditation policy for professional certificates, and the recognitions of transfer credits as concrete proposals of academic interactions and exchanges.
4. To conduct the on-going assessment describing the relationship between the two institutions. The major concerns include, not limit to, feasible cooperative patterns, academic development, pioneering curriculum development and research integration



This Memorandum of Understanding as well as succeeding plans of cooperation shall be effective after approval of the terms of the later agreement by the appropriate authorities of the institutions. Cancellation of this memorandum may be effected by either party with a written notice one year prior to the anticipated termination.
